MESSAGE FROM CANTOR JEN ROHER

Starting a New Book - January 2023

Let me begin by saying, Happy secular New Year! In Jewish tradition we have many different opportunities to say Happy New Year, and certainly we can't turn down another opportunity to begin again, an opportunity for a new start, for renewed enthusiasm and motivation. So, Happy New Year! January at the Temple holds some special new beginnings for our community and some special celebrations.

At the beginning of January, we will finish the Book of Genesis, the book that defines the Jewish family. We then begin the Book of Exodus, the story of the Israelites going out from a constricted place into the wilderness. These past many months, we have been involved in a period of looking inward, of reinvigorating our Temple community as we have come somewhat out of the pandemic, restoring our joyful and popular Shabbat services and dinners, regathering for Holy Days and re-energizing our community.

This January, we begin not an Exodus, but perhaps the reverse - welcome visitors from the outside in. Our rabbinic search committee has been very busy reading resumes and conducting initial interviews with a number of stellar candidates, and in January we will begin welcoming prospective rabbis to our Temple home. Many of you will have the chance to meet and learn from these candidates as they interface with our community in a variety of ways.

In addition, we will welcome two more visiting rabbis this spring. First, Rabbi Julie Schwartz will visit the first weekend of February. Rabbi Schwartz is Associate Dean of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion in Cincinnati and has wisdom to share from a variety of experiences and leadership positions. Later in the spring, we will welcome Rabbi Karyn Kedar, Rabbi Emerita of B'nai Jehoshua Beth Elohim in Deerfield, Illinois, as well as welcoming Rabbi Arnie Sleutelberg back to our congregation for another special visit.

We stand at a pivotal time in our Temple's history. We have this rare opportunity, during this extended year of transition, to open ourselves to encountering many different rabbis and learning from a host of gifted teachers. Already, we have welcomed Rabbi Jamie Gibson, our visiting Interim Rabbi. I also had the chance to welcome Rabbi Matt Green and Rabbi David Sofian to the bimah in December. It is a year of opportunity, and I hope you will all take advantage of the gifts these many rabbis have to offer.

So as we begin our "next book" this January, please join me as we welcome our guests, and give them a big Temple hello. The Israelites encountered all kinds of miracles and wonders on their journey in the Book of Exodus - if we are open to seeing them, hopefully we will encounter them too.

Rabbi Schwartz is Associate Professor of Clinical Pastoral Education and Pastoral Care at Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion in Cincinnati, OH. Among her duties each year are teaching the foundational course in human relations, conducting a retreat on Rabbinic Ethics, and serving as the Rabbi for the chapel. She also teaches a rotation of elective courses including *Psychology and Film: Finding Our Congregants, Life Cycle and Transitions*, and *Spiritual Techniques and Mindfulness*.

Her many credits include Senior Rabbi, Temple Emanu-El of Greater Atlanta; Director, Rabbinic Alumni Association, Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion/Director of Continuing Rabbinic Education; and Chaplain, LT United States Naval Reserve, Stationed at Oakland Naval Hospital. Rabbi Schwartz has the distinction of being the first woman rabbi to serve as an active duty military chaplain.

- 3) Request must be for attendance at a URJ camp, or any other non-denominational Jewish camp (i.e., JCC run camp)
- 4) Must be an overnight camp.
- 5) Applicant must submit request in writing by February 1, 2023
