

### RABBI'S REFLECTIONS

February, 2023/Shevat-Adar 5783

February is the longest, shortest, coldest month. I think we can agree on that. For me, three secular events make this month tolerable: Groundhog Day, Valentine's Day and whatever date this month pitchers report for spring training (as you may remember, I am a forlorn fan of the Pittsburgh Pirates, which serves as much as a minor league team as the Toledo Mudhens here).

Two events in the Jewish calendar, however, fill me with hope. The first is **Tu B'Shevat**, or the New Year of the Trees, which comes Sunday-Monday, February 5-£. It is on this day in Israel that the sap runs down the trunks of trees so we know that the vital juices of the world are unfreezing.

The second is **Rosh Chodesh Adar**, or the new moon of the month of Adar, which is February 21-22 this year. Our wise Rabbis taught, *Mi she-nich-nas Adar marbin b'simcha* – "Whoever enters Adar increases happiness."

What makes for this happiness? Well, besides spring training, the lavender in the Galilee is in full bloom (I've seen it up close). Adar also means that Purim is coming, with its topsy-turvy joy! Dressing up, indulging in food and drink (I'm a sucker for poppyseed hamantaschen, prune, not so much). This year Purim is Monday-Tuesday March 6-7. I also love a good Purim spiel, especially one that makes Queen Vashti a hero!

This year, as you may know, Disney songs are at the heart of this year's Shomer Emunim Purim Spiel. So by the time Adar comes, I'm all set to just "Let It Go!" (from "Frozen"). I won't be with you for this year's spiel so I hope you will "Remember Me" (from "Coco").

Although I'll miss Purim, I will be in town for St. Patrick's Day, another occasion to enjoy ourselves thoroughly! Although it will have been a month, don't worry, "I Know The Way" (from Moana) back to this wonderful synagogue!

Whether you survive February with marathon viewings of the movie "Groundhog Day" (it's actually a very religious film!), eating the fruit of different trees for Tu B'Shevat, partaking of copious amounts of chocolate for Valentine's Day, reveling in the onset of Adar or just hoping that pitchers get down to Florida or out to Arizona without hurting themselves, I wish you the blessing of hope for a calm end to winter and a lovely spring to come.

On a personal note – I am delighted that my colleague and personal friend, Rabbi Julie Schwartz, will pervisiting Temple the first Shabbat this month. She has been a powerful role model for generations of Rabbis who studied for ordination at Hebrew Union College-Jewish institute of Religion in Cincinnati (where I was ordained in 1983). I am thrilled that you will have the opportunity to learn Torah and be inspired by her. Rabbi Schwartz is a treasure!

Rabbi Julie Schwartz will be joining us at The Temple February 3 and 4 as Scholar-in-Residence. She will lead Shabbat Services with Cantor Roher on Friday, February 3.

She also teaches a rotation of elective courses including *Psychology and Film: Finding Our Congregants, Life Cycle and Transitions*, a d *Spiritual Techniques and Mindfulness*.

Her many credits include Senior Rabbi, Temple Emanu-El of Greater Atlanta; Director, Rabbinic Alumni Association, Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion/Director of Continuing Rabbinic Education; and Chaplain, LT United States Naval Reserve, Stationed at Jakland Naval Hospital. Rabbi Schwartz has the distinction of being the first woman rabbi to serve as an active duty military chaplain.




