Last Day of Religious School/Teacher Appreciation

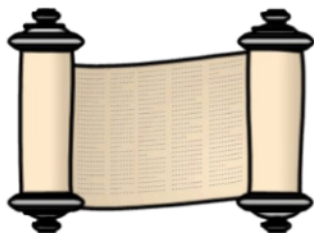
